# Zion: The Dwelling Place of God and the Hope of His People

## Day 1 - Zion: God's Chosen Dwelling Place

*Reading: Psalm 132:13-14*

Verse: "For the Lord has chosen Zion, He has desired it for His dwelling, saying, 'This is my resting place forever and ever; here I will sit enthroned, for I have desired it.'"

Devotional Thought: God doesn't dwell in places chosen by human wisdom-He chooses places and people based on His purpose and presence. Zion became the heart of worship in Israel, not because of its location, but because God chose to dwell there. Today, He chooses to dwell in us.

Reflection Questions:

- What does it mean for your life that God has chosen to dwell in you?
- Are there areas of your heart where you need to make room for God's presence?

Prayer Focus: Invite God to dwell richly in every part of your life. Ask Him to make your heart a place of His rest.



- How can you grow in spiritual stability this week?

Prayer Focus: Ask God to help you become immovable in faith, trusting Him even in difficult times.



- How are you participating in God's global vision for worship and discipleship?

- Who in your life needs an invitation to experience God's presence?

Prayer Focus: Pray for the nations. Ask God to give you a heart for the lost and to use you as a bridge to bring others into His Kingdom.



- Are you more focused on earthly matters or on eternal ones?

Prayer Focus: Thank God for the hope of heaven. Ask Him to help you live with a heavenly perspective each day.



- How can you cultivate a deeper lifestyle of praise?

Prayer Focus: Praise God for who He is. Spend time in joyful worship, thanking Him for His presence and promises.



## **Closing Reflection:**

Zion is more than a mountain or a city-it's a reality of God's presence, power, and promise. As you reflect on these truths, may your heart become a Zion: a resting place for God, unshakable in faith, and full of joy.
